Admission Requirements for Foreign (non-Turkish citizen) Applicants

- Undergraduate degree in international relations, political science, international relations and political science, political science and public administration, economics, sociology, religious studies, history or business administration
- Undergraduate GPA 2.5/4.0 or higher
- TOEFL iBT score of 66 or higher to apply, and 96 or higher to begin the MA program. Admitted students with TOEFL iBT scores between 66-96 are required to attend the English prep school before beginning the MA program. Equivalent language scores from other exams (CPE, CAE, PTE Academic, KPDS, ÜDS, YDS) are also accepted. Native speakers of English are exempt from this requirement
- 100 TL application fee (nonrefundable) paid to IBAN TR76 0001 2009 4110 0006 0000 14. The program's annual tuition is 10,000 TL

The following documents are required for admission:

- Undergraduate diploma or temporary graduation document (undergraduate institution must be recognized by the Turkish Council of Higher Education –YÖK)
- Undergraduate transcript
- English test score
- Your photo (passport photo size)
